# KANANA

*Bordering the renowned Moremi Game Reserve, this is one of Botswana's most enchanting and ecologically rich wilderness areas.*



Kanana Camp is an exquisite, hidden jewel, privately set along the Xudum River in the southwest of the magnificent Okavango Delta. The landscape is a breathtaking tapestry, unfolding as a necklace of palm-studded islands interwoven with towering fig, ebony, marula, and knobthorn trees. This richly textured habitat teems with life, providing a sanctuary for a diverse abundance of birds and wildlife. This exceptional biodiversity makes Kanana the ideal setting to experience the full, spectacular spectrum of species that define the Okavango Delta. With the arrival of the annual floods (typically May through September), parts of the exclusive concession transform into a shimmering water paradise. This dynamic environment assures travelers the very best of both worlds: exhilarating land-based game drives and the unique, serene perspective of water-based safaris.



## *Kanana features*

- Kanana is renowned for its rich wildlife and focuses on game drive excursions.
- From May through September annually, the Okavango Delta's floods arrive, complementing game drives with mokoro (dugout canoe) and boat cruises (should the water levels be deep enough).
- A haven for birdlife, Kanana is also home to the largest heronry in the Okavango Delta, a place where thousands of storks, herons, egrets and rare pink-backed pelican nest on woodland waterberry islands in the water.
- Frequent predator sightings such as lion, leopard and painted wild dogs.

## *Facilities*

- Kanana offers an exquisite sanctuary in the Delta, featuring eight classic, landscape-oriented safari tents and one spacious family tent, all ideally placed beneath the deep, protective canopy of the mature riverine woodland. From each verandah, a seemingly endless floodplain stretches out front, providing the perfect vantage to enjoy the midday and observe the regular wildlife procession. Each tent features a spacious room with a King bed (draped with a mosquito net), a coffee station and minibar, and an en-suite bathroom with double vanities and an indoor shower.
- Kanana's elevated central lounge, dining and bar area have the finest views over the seasonally inundated grassy floodplain, a wildlife magnet. Several lounge areas, a family styled dining table, outdoor private dining, serviced bar area and large fireplace at ground level give multiple areas for guests to enjoy this wilderness.
- Maximum 18 Guests (2026) and Maximum 16 Guests (2027)



### *Additional Facilities*

- Curio shop
- 1 central Pool
- A “craft your own” Pizza Oven area
- In-house Spa (from 1 March 2027, at additional cost)

### *Location*

- Kanana is in the Southwest Okavango Delta, West of Chief’s Island.
- A short 20 minute flight from Maun to Kanana.

### *Excursions*

- Nature drives by day and night, with off-road access to profile sighting
- Guided, armed Nature walks
- Fishing (Seasonal)
- Mokoro excursions (Seasonal between May and September, variable)
- Boating activities (Seasonal between June and end August, variable)
- 1 split level Sleep out Deck (at additional cost). The upper deck has a King bed under the stars, overlooking a grassy floodplain, and an ensuite bathroom (shower and toilet). Below is an outdoor bar, dining space, comfortable seating and a roaring fire out the front of the decked sleep out.
- Private excursions (1 vehicle per camp, at additional cost)
