MAXA

A camp within an area of raw beauty, Maxa inspires the safari travellers' Explorer's spirit to adventure and discover its wildlife.



Nestled beneath the verdant canopy of an ancient riverine forest, Maxa Camp presides over the expansive, hippo-filled Maxa Lagoon in the northeastern Okavango Delta. Situated at the heart of the vast KAZA Transfrontier Conservation Area—a wilderness region nearly half the size of California—Maxa's prime location is the remarkable point where the Delta's waters converge with the headwaters of the iconic Selinda Spillway. This unique vantage point assures access to a labyrinth of diverse landscapes, ever-shifting habitats, and winding waterways, providing an exceptional base for wildlife exploration.



Maxa features

- Small and intimate.
- Combination of land (game driving) and water-based (seasonal boating and mokoro) activities.
- Maxa is home to a rich diversity of wildlife, including zebra, buffalo, elephant, crocodile, hippo, giraffe, alongside predators such as lion, leopard, wild dog and hyena.

Facilities

- 4 stretch canvas tents on wooden decks and 1 family tent with two double beds separated by a headboard (shared bathroom).
- Each tent has an indoor and outdoor shower.
- The central stretch-styled canvas lounge/ bar and a separate dining tent are linked by a warm and inviting outdoor fireplace.
- Maximum 12 guests.
- The central dining area features an outdoor pizza oven, where baking, roasts, and pizzas are made.
- Indoor and outdoor dining.
- Outdoor fireplace.
- 1 swimming pool - Eco pool.
- 2 elevated observation decks overlook the Maxa lagoon.



Excursions

- Game drives - day and night, with off-road access to profile sightings
- Guided, armed nature walks
- Fishing (seasonal)
- Mokoro excursions (dugout canoe)
- Boating (seasonal and limited to between May to end September)

Location

- Northern Okavango Delta, and East of the delta's panhandle.
- A 45-minute flight from Maun to Mapula Airstrip – then 5-minute helicopter transfer to Maxa
