# OKUTI

*Situated within the wilderness of Botswana's renowned Moremi Game Reserve in the Okavango Delta, one of the country's premier game-viewing destinations, Okuti occupies a prime location of Xakanaxa.*



The mosaic of protected and varied habitats supports an exceptional diversity of wildlife, ensuring consistently rewarding sightings throughout the year.

Inspired by the gently flowing Maunachira River that runs in front of camp, Okuti is a sanctuary of serenity surrounded by abundant birdlife, thriving wildlife populations in their picturesque lagoons, grassy floodplains and woodlands. The rhythm of the water defines the experience here, creating a sense of calm that permeates every moment.

Combining prime positioning with thoughtful comfort, Okuti offers one of the best-value safari experiences in the greater Okavango Delta region, delivering remarkable wildlife encounters on land, along with explorations of the Okavango's largest lagoons, the Gudikgwa Lagoons, by varied boat types.



## *Okuti features*

- The Xakanaxa region is one of the rare areas of the Okavango where guests can enjoy the full suite of water-based activities coupled with productive and exciting game drives, with both terrestrial and aquatic antelope.
- The area is best explored by game drives and boating excursions (barge, motorboat and mokoro- dugout canoe).
- Wildlife regularly encountered include buffalo, giraffe, zebra, kudu, warthog, impala, red lechwe and possibly even a sitatunga, the Okavango's elusive water antelope. It is renowned for its predators, which include lion, leopard, hyena and wild dogs, amongst others.
- Okuti is a birder's paradise, with a very diverse range of species who each inhabit their niche in one of the many habitats.

## *Facilities*

- 7 tented rooms, which includes two family rooms, have a King bed, surrounded by a honey coloured mosquito net and face the view beyond the outdoor verandah. A small lounge, handcrafted dressing table and closet assure in-room comforts, while the bathroom has double vanities, and an indoor and outdoor shower.
- Okuti's tented rooms face out upon the Maunachira Channel, one of the Okavango Delta's largest, and out across the reed/ papyrus beds stretching to the forested edge in the far distance.
- Curio shop.
- 1 central pool.
- Outdoor Fireplace.



## *Additional Facilities*

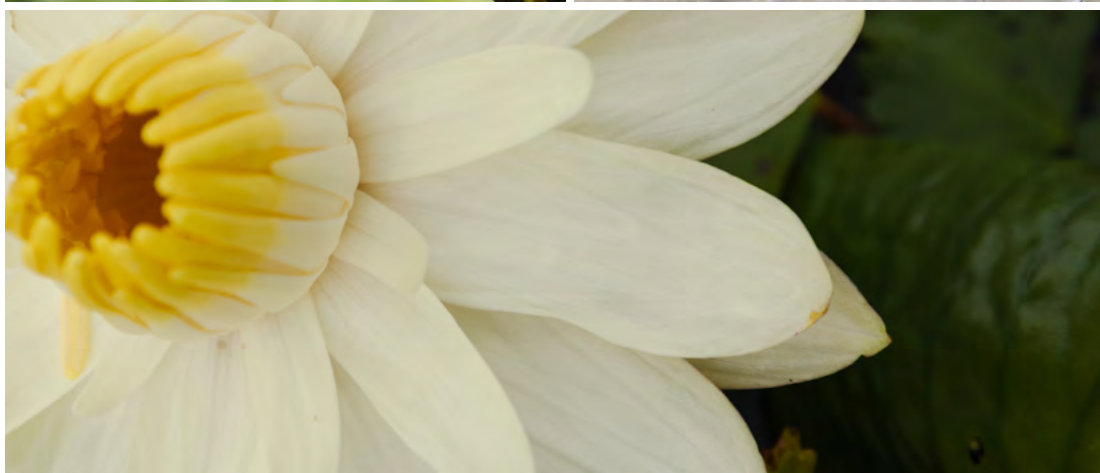
- The camp's elevated lounge and separate dining room mirror the stunning views over the Maunachira River. This central lounge/ bar is the social heart of Okuti—a favorite gathering spot featuring comfortable leather couches, a well-stocked self-service bar, and a curated mini-library. Designed for relaxation and connection, this inviting space effortlessly encourages friendly, jovial discussions between guests and our dedicated team, making moments you spend here feel like coming home.

## *Excursions*

- Game drives (daytime only, no off-road driving)
- Mokoro (dugout canoe)
- Boat cruises (motorboat)
- A special experience for guests at Okuti is the double deck barge. This craft elevates guests on the upper deck above the reeds, allowing for extraordinary sunsets observing miles around, 360-degree views, the splendour of the Okavango. For brunch/ lunch at OKuti, guests are treated to a barge meal, complete with a barbeque on board, harvest-styled salads, and beverages while effortlessly cruising along the channels and lagoons in cool comfort.
- Basket weaving (a tea-time experience with the camp staff ladies)
- Private excursions (1 vehicle per camp, at additional cost)
