SHINDE

Nestled beneath the deep shade of a lush, forested island in the heart of the northern Okavango Delta.



Shinde's central area, comprising its elevated lounges and dining spaces offer sweeping views across the Delta's shimmering lagoons and winding waterways of Shinde Lagoon, assuring an immersive connection to the rhythms of the Okavango Delta.

Celebrated for its exceptional diversity of mammals and birdlife, Shinde's prime location in the Northern Okavango ensures an enviable combination of water-based activities, game drives, and guided nature walks across some of the Delta's most picturesque floodplains and islands. This rich mosaic of habitats supports an impressive concentration of wildlife, including the elusive sitatunga antelope and a thriving population of leopard.



Shinde features

- Year-round water (boat/ mokoro) and land (game drives and nature walks) activities.
- Popular for predator sightings such as lion, leopard and wild dog, along with attendant scavengers.
- Rich diversity of aquatic and terrestrial herbivores, including hippo, buffalo, elephant, kudu, lechwe, waterbuck, giraffe, and zebra.

Facilities

- 7 classic safari tents beneath traditional thatched roofs and 1 family tent. Each spacious tent features a spacious room with a King bed (with mosquito net), a coffee station and minibar, an enclosed en-suite bathroom with double vanities and an indoor shower (as well as one outdoor shower). A shaded verandah offers a tranquil setting to relax between activities.
- Each safari tent is thoughtfully positioned along the forested fringes of the island, some overlook grassy floodplains, while others gaze out across the tranquil waterways.
- Curio shop
- 1 central pool
- Outdoor fireplace
- Indoor and outdoor dining
- In-house Spa (additional cost)
- Camp is linked by an elevated boardwalk.
- Private excursions (1 vehicle per camp, at additional cost)



Excursions

- Game drives - day and night, with off-road access to profile sightings
- Guided, armed nature walks
- Fishing (seasonal)
- Mokoro excursions (dugout canoe)
- Boating (exploring lagoons and one of the Okavango Delta's main channels, the Maunachira)

Location

- Northern Okavango Delta, bordering Moremi Game Reserve.
- A scenic 30-minute Northbound flight from/ to Maun
