



As you are aware our camps are located in remote wilderness areas and self-flying to our airstrips can present some risks.

To manage these risks, we have several measures in place that we would like to make you aware of.

Firstly, in the event of an incident we are required to be able to identify aircraft en-route to our camps or within our area. Full aircraft details are required.

Secondly, when landing, our camp guides must make sure the runway is free of wild animals that frequent the area and clear for landing. Our policy is that the guide must be at the airstrip 15 minutes prior to the planes scheduled time of landing.

With this in mind, it is imperative we have accurate information with regards to the arrival time of self-fly planes, without such information we cannot ensure the airstrip is clear for landing.

Therefore, we would really appreciate if you could provide us with the following information:

- **48 hours before the arrival date**, please advise:
 - the aircraft registration number & country of origin,
 - type of aircraft,
 - pilot's name and telephone number,
 - contact names and telephone numbers (including Emergency/afterhours/weekends),
 - Expected arrival time at our camp.

The Airstrip Indemnity form for Kanana or Shinde needs to be completed and signed by your clients and returned to us.

- **24 hours before the arrival date**, provide the flight plan from the point of departure to our camps with all the stop overs and ETA & ETD for each of them.
If the clients stop at Maun Airport on the way to our camp, we can provide a **Meet & Greet service**. We would then check with the pilot directly regarding ETD and ETA for our camp.
- **Day of travel**, if you have provide us with the link to your tracking website, we will track the aircraft ourselves. Otherwise, we would need the name of a contact person who we could liaise with.
- **Day before departure from our camp**, the clients must organise the ETD directly with the camp manager
- **Day of departure**, should you wish, we are able to advise the next camp or any third party of your ETD from our camp.
- **Aircraft Park fees (P250.00** per day per aircraft) are to be paid by the pilot at the Department of Wildlife & National Parks (DWNP) office upon arrival at Xakanaka Airstrip when going to Okuti. The camp guide will help the guests with those formalities.
- **No payment is required for the use of Shinde or Kanana airstrips**
